## Easter Sunday

April 17<sup>th</sup> (Acts 10:34a,37-43 | Col 3:1-4 | Jn 20:1-9)



**Significance of Easter:** "Easter" literally means "the feast of fresh flowers." Easter is the greatest and the most important feast in the Church for four reasons:

**1) The Resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian Faith.**

It is the greatest of the miracles, for it proves that Jesus is God. That is why St. Paul writes: "*If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your Faith is in vain*" (I Cor 15:14). "**Jesus is Lord, He is risen**" (Rom 10:9), was the central theme of the *kerygma* (or "preaching"), of the Apostles

**2) Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection.**

Jesus assured Martha at the tomb of Lazarus: "*I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me will live even though he dies...*" (Jn 11:25-26).

**3) Easter is a feast which gives us hope and encouragement in this world of pain, sorrows and tears.**

It reminds us that life is worth living. It also gives us strength to fight against temptations and freedom from unnecessary worries and fears.

**4) Easter gives meaning to our prayers:** It supports our belief in the Real Presence of the Risen Jesus in and around us, in His Church, in the Blessed Sacrament and in Heaven, hearing our prayers, and so gives meaning to our personal as well as our communal prayers.

**Reasons why we believe in the Resurrection of Jesus** (1) **Jesus himself testified to his Resurrection from the dead, giving it as a sign of his divinity.** ([Mark 8:31](#); [Matthew 17:22](#); [Luke 9:22](#)). *"Tear down this temple and in three days I will build it again"* (Jn 2: 19).

(2) **The tomb was empty on Easter Sunday ([Luke 24:3](#))**. Although the guards claimed ([Matthew 28:13](#)), that the disciples of Jesus had stolen the body, every sensible Jew knew that it was impossible for the terrified disciples of Jesus to steal the body of Jesus from a tomb guarded by an armed, 16-member Roman Guard detachment.

(3) **The initial disbelief of Jesus' own disciples** in Jesus' Resurrection, in spite of His repeated apparitions, serves as a strong proof of his Resurrection. Their initial disbelief explains why the Apostles started preaching the Risen Christ only after receiving the anointing of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost.

(4) **The transformation of Jesus' disciples:** Jesus' Resurrection and the anointing of the Holy Spirit transformed men who were hopeless and fearful after the crucifixion ([Luke 24:21](#), [John](#)

[20:19](#)), into men who now were confident and bold witnesses to the Resurrection ([Acts 2:24, 3:15, 4:2](#)) powerfully preaching the Risen Lord.

(5) **Neither the Jews nor the Romans could disprove Jesus' Resurrection** by presenting the dead body of Jesus.

(6) **The Apostles and early Christians would not have fearlessly preached Christ as Savior and faced martyrdom** if they were not absolutely sure of Jesus' Resurrection.

(7) **The Apostle Paul's conversion from a persecutor of Christians to a zealous preacher of Jesus supports the truth of Jesus' Resurrection** ([Galatians 1:11-17, Acts 9:1, Acts 9:24-25, Acts 26:15-18](#)).

(8) The sheer existence of a thriving, empire-conquering early Christian Church, bravely facing and surviving three centuries of persecution, supports the truth of the Resurrection claim.

(9) **The New Testament witnesses do not bear the stamp of dupes or deceivers. The Apostles and the early Christians were absolutely sure about the Resurrection of Jesus.**

**Life Messages:** 1) **Let us live the lives of Resurrection people:** We are not supposed to lie buried in the tomb of our sins, evil habits, dangerous addictions, despair, discouragement or doubts. Instead, we are expected to live a joyful and peaceful life, constantly experiencing the living presence of the Risen Lord Who loves us in all the events of our lives and amid the boredom, suffering, pain and tensions of our day-to-day life.

2) **The conviction of the real presence of the Risen Lord with us and within us and all around us, enables us to lead disciplined Christian lives.** It will help us to control our thoughts, desires, words, behavior and actions.

3) **This salutary awareness of the presence of the Risen Lord within us inspires us to honor our bodies,** keeping them holy, pure and free from evil habits and addictions. Our conviction that the loving presence of the Risen Lord dwells in our neighbors and in all those we encounter, should encourage us to respect them and to render them loving, humble and selfless service.

4) **We need to become transparent Christians, radiating the Risen Lord around us** in the form of selfless and sacrificial agape love, mercy, compassion and a spirit of humble service. each time we try to practice Christian charity, mercy and forgiveness and each time we fight against temptations, we share in the Resurrection of Jesus. ## GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Happy Easter! When I think about Easter when I was a child, I admit that many of my memories are centered more around its symbolic trappings: Fannie Mae Easter eggs and peppermint ice cream, my grandma's table set just so, and unseasonably cold Easter egg hunts. While I may not have yet fully understood the theology of the Resurrection, being at Mass with my family and taking part in the celebratory activities engendered in me the disposition of which the psalmist speaks: *This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad.* Today's readings invite us to see both the secular and the sacred with new eyes. The fact that Jesus took on our humanity, died and rose again give us a glimpse of the joy that awaits. The simple pleasures we experience at Easter and throughout the year hint at what the Lord has in mind for all of us. In the meantime, we can turn to Jesus for encouragement, with the knowledge that God is present in the ordinary and extraordinary people and events in our daily lives.

## PRAY

As this Easter season begins, we celebrate Christ's triumph over death, yet mourn that death still comes so violently for so many around the world. Make an extra effort – an extraordinary effort – this week to pray for peace in the world.

¡Felices Pascuas! Cuando pienso en la Pascua cuando era niño, admito que muchos de mis recuerdos se centran más en sus adornos simbólicos: huevos de Pascua de Fannie Mae y helado de menta, la mesa de mi abuela puesta así y búsquedas de huevos de Pascua inusualmente frías. Si bien es posible que aún no haya entendido completamente la teología de la Resurrección, estar en Misa con mi familia y participar en las actividades de celebración engendró en mí la disposición de la que habla el salmista: Este es el día que hizo el Señor; regocijémonos y alegrémonos. Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a ver tanto lo secular como lo sagrado con nuevos ojos. El hecho de que Jesús asumió nuestra humanidad, murió y resucitó nos da un atisbo de la alegría que nos espera. Los placeres sencillos que experimentamos en Pascua y durante todo el año dan una idea de lo que el Señor tiene en mente para todos nosotros. Mientras tanto, podemos acudir a Jesús en busca de aliento, con el conocimiento de que Dios está presente en las personas y los acontecimientos ordinarios y extraordinarios de nuestra vida diaria.

## REZA

## GO EVANGELIZE

### PAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

After Mary Magdalene discovers the empty tomb, Simon Peter and “the other disciple” (John) don’t walk – but run to the tomb. I’m struck by the detailed account that follows. Peter “saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place.” The words that follow seem contradictory: “Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.” Their understanding would grow in the hours and days that followed. These early witnesses would then share the Good News of Jesus’ resurrection, often at the cost of their own lives, building up the Church that endures today. Like the disciples, we, too, are commissioned to witness to our faith in the risen Jesus, sharing this life-changing reality with others through our words and actions.

## ANDA EVANGELIZA

### ORANDO, INVITANDO, TESTIFICANDO, ACOMPAÑANDO

Después de que María Magdalena descubre la tumba vacía, Simón Pedro y “el otro discípulo” (Juan) no caminan, sino que corren hacia la tumba. Me sorprende el relato detallado que sigue. Pedro “vio allí las vendas del entierro, y la venda que cubría su cabeza, no con las vendas del entierro sino enrollada en un lugar aparte”. Las palabras que siguen parecen contradictorias: “Entonces entró también el otro discípulo, el que había llegado primero al sepulcro, y vio y creyó. Porque aún no entendían la Escritura de que tenía que resucitar de entre los muertos.” Su comprensión crecería en las horas y días siguientes. Estos primeros testigos luego compartirían las Buenas Nuevas de la resurrección de Jesús, a menudo a costa de sus propias vidas, edificando la Iglesia que perdura hoy. Al igual que los discípulos, nosotros también estamos encargados de dar testimonio de nuestra fe en Jesús resucitado, compartiendo esta realidad transformadora con otros a través de nuestras palabras y acciones.

**Jesus had come back to life!**



**Mary Magdalene Meets the Risen Jesus**



## Domingo de Pascua

17º de Abril (Acts 10:34a,37-43 | Col 3:1-4| Jn 20:1-9)

Significado de la Pascua: "Pascua" significa literalmente "la fiesta de las flores frescas". La Pascua es la fiesta más grande y más importante de la Iglesia por cuatro razones:

1) La Resurrección de Cristo es la base de nuestra fe cristiana. Es el más grande de los milagros, porque prueba que Jesús es Dios. Por eso San Pablo escribe: "Si Cristo no resucitó, vana es entonces nuestra predicación; y vuestra Fe es en vano" (I Cor 15,14). "Jesús es el Señor, ha resucitado" (Rm 10,9), fue el tema central del kerygma (o "predicación") de los Apóstoles

2) La Pascua es la garantía de nuestra propia resurrección. Jesús aseguró a Marta en la tumba de Lázaro: "Yo soy la resurrección y la vida; el que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá..." (Jn 11, 25-26).

3) La Pascua es una fiesta que nos da esperanza y aliento en este mundo de dolor, tristeza y lágrimas. Nos recuerda que vale la pena vivir la vida. También nos da fuerza para luchar contra las tentaciones y liberarnos de preocupaciones y temores innecesarios.

4) La Pascua da sentido a nuestras oraciones: apoya nuestra creencia en la Presencia Real de Jesús Resucitado en y alrededor de nosotros, en Su Iglesia, en el Santísimo Sacramento y en el Cielo, escuchando nuestras oraciones, y así da sentido a nuestra vida personal. así como nuestras oraciones comunitarias.

**Razones por las que creemos en la Resurrección de Jesús**

(1) Jesús mismo dio testimonio de su Resurrección de entre los muertos, dándola como señal de su divinidad. (Marcos 8,31; Mateo 17,22; Lucas 9,22). Derribad este templo y en tres días lo volveré a edificar" (Jn 2, 19).

(2) La tumba estaba vacía el Domingo de Pascua (Lucas 24:3). Aunque los guardias afirmaron (Mateo 28:13), que los discípulos de Jesús habían robado el cuerpo, todo judío sensato sabía que era imposible que los aterrorizados discípulos de Jesús robaran el cuerpo de Jesús de una tumba custodiada por un armado, 16 - miembro del destacamento de la Guardia Romana.

(3) La incredulidad inicial de los propios discípulos de Jesús en la Resurrección de Jesús, a pesar de Sus repetidas apariciones, sirve como una fuerte prueba de su Resurrección. Su incredulidad inicial explica por qué los Apóstoles comenzaron a predicar a Cristo Resucitado solo después de recibir la unción del Espíritu Santo en el día de Pentecostés.

(4) La transformación de los discípulos de Jesús: la resurrección de Jesús y la unción del Espíritu Santo transformaron a los hombres que estaban desesperanzados y temerosos después de la crucifixión (Lucas 24:21, Juan 20:19), en hombres que ahora tenían confianza y valor testigos de la Resurrección (Hechos 2:24, 3:15, 4:2) predicando poderosamente al Señor Resucitado.

(5) Ni los judíos ni los romanos podían refutar la resurrección de Jesús presentando el cuerpo muerto de Jesús.

(6) Los Apóstoles y los primeros cristianos no habrían predicado valientemente a Cristo como Salvador y enfrentado el martirio si no hubieran estado absolutamente seguros de la Resurrección de Jesús.

(7) La conversión del apóstol Pablo de un perseguidor de cristianos a un celoso predicador de Jesús respalda la verdad de la resurrección de Jesús (Gálatas 1:11-17, Hechos 9:1, Hechos 9:24-25, Hechos 26:15- 18).

(8) La mera existencia de una iglesia cristiana primitiva próspera y conquistadora del imperio, que enfrentó valientemente y sobrevivió a tres siglos de persecución, respalda la verdad de la afirmación de la resurrección.

(9) Los testigos del Nuevo Testamento no llevan el sello de embaucadores o engañadores. Los Apóstoles y los primeros cristianos estaban absolutamente seguros de la Resurrección de Jesús.

**Mensajes de vida:** 1) Vivamos la vida de la gente de la Resurrección: no debemos estar enterrados en la tumba de nuestros pecados, malos hábitos, adicciones peligrosas, desesperación, desánimo o dudas. En cambio, se espera que vivamos una vida alegre y pacífica, experimentando constantemente la presencia viva del Señor Resucitado que nos ama en todos los acontecimientos de nuestra vida y en medio del aburrimiento, el sufrimiento, el dolor y las tensiones de nuestra vida cotidiana. .

2) La convicción de la presencia real del Señor Resucitado con nosotros y dentro de nosotros ya nuestro alrededor, nos capacita para llevar una vida cristiana disciplinada. Nos ayudará a controlar nuestros pensamientos, deseos, palabras, comportamiento y acciones.

3) Esta saludable conciencia de la presencia del Resucitado en nosotros nos inspira a honrar nuestros cuerpos, manteniéndolos santos, puros y libres de malos hábitos y adicciones. Nuestra convicción de que la presencia amorosa del Señor Resucitado habita en nuestro prójimo y en todos aquellos con los que nos encontramos, debe alestarnos a respetarlos y a prestarles un servicio amoroso, humilde y desinteresado.

4) Necesitamos convertirnos en cristianos transparentes, irradiando al Señor Resucitado a nuestro alrededor en forma de amor ágate desinteresado y sacrificado, misericordia, compasión y un espíritu de servicio humilde. cada vez que tratamos de practicar la caridad cristiana, la misericordia y el perdón y cada vez que luchamos contra las tentaciones, participamos de la Resurrección de Jesús.
