

## Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

January 22<sup>nd</sup> (Is 8:23-9:3 | 1 Cor 1:10-13, 17 | Mt 4:12-23)

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE:

#### PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Since the Fall, the world has been riddled with strife and divisiveness. From the disobedience in the Garden, to Cain and Abel, to conflicts and wars throughout the centuries, it's clear that we humans are prone to picking sides and fighting over them. We hear about this even within the early Church from St. Paul in today's second reading. There were rivalries, and Christians were saying things such as, "I belong to Paul" or "I belong to Cephas." But Paul wisely asks: "Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?" Clearly not. There is only one source of Truth – Jesus Christ – and Paul never hesitated to refuse credit for himself, and to instead glorify the Lord in his word and deed. This is the model set for us – to refuse to set ourselves or God-made-in-our-own-image over and against the Triune God who created us. Christ came to unite us with himself and to one another, in reconciliation with the Father. His words are now our words: Repent and believe in the Gospel. Pray for the grace to come together as the body of Christ so that we can be his hands and feet in the world and carry out the work he began.

### GO EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In Jesus Christ the kingdom of God enters into human history, fulfilling God's promise of salvation for his people. Christ inaugurated the kingdom on earth, and as members of his Church we are responsible for continuing to build it – here and now. As Christ called his first disciples and made them "fishers of men," so he calls us, that we might go forth "proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people."

**PRAY:** The Lord has commissioned us to take the Gospel to the ends of the earth. Where we cannot go physically or in person, we can go in prayer. Bring before the Lord all who yet need to hear his voice and repent and believe. Pray for those who are persecuted for their belief in Jesus Christ.

## FRIDAY FEBRUARY 3<sup>rd</sup>

We celebrate the feast of Saint Blaise, who was bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. We pray in a special way that day for protection from afflictions of the throat and from other illnesses. The blessing of Saint Blaise is a sign of our faith in God's protection and love for us and for the sick. Blessings will be during Friday February 3 in the Chapel at 8:30AM.

## HOW TO CONNECT WITH GOD THROUGH PRAYER (Part 1)

### Jeremiah 29:12-14

And you shall call upon me, and you shall go: and you shall pray to me, and I will hear you.

You shall seek me, and shall find me: when you shall seek me with all your heart.

### Introduction

As children of God we have received many gifts, one of them is the mind which we use to think. Through our reasoning and then our faith we accept that there is a God who listens not only to our words but to our thoughts.

When we pray we come in supplication before God or any superior spiritual being like Our Lady, the saints or the angels. We present our entreaties with humility, and we expect to be answered.

We live before God, and He sees everything that we do, He knows our needs and desires, He is very generous and He wants to give us His gifts, but we have to cultivate a relationship with Him based on a spiritual life, where prayer is indispensable to our progress.

As we pray we come closer to God and we may ask and obtain what we want, we may knock and He will open the door, we may search and we can find [\[Matthew 7:7-8\]](#).

This sounds too good to be true, and yet this is so real. We can open the treasures of God with the keys of humility, trust and prayer.

In the words of Padre Pio we should live our lives with this attitude: "Pray, hope and don't worry".

## Tercer Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

22° de Enero (Is 8:23-9:3 | 1 Cor 1:10-13, 17 | Mt 4:12-23)

### CRECER COMO DISCÍPULO: ORA, ESTUDIA, PARTICIPA, SERVE

Desde la Caída, el mundo ha estado plagado de conflictos y divisiones. Desde la desobediencia en el Jardín, a Caín y Abel, a los conflictos y guerras a lo largo de los siglos, está claro que los humanos somos propensos a tomar partido y pelear por ellos. Escuchamos sobre esto incluso dentro de la Iglesia primitiva de San Pablo en la segunda lectura de hoy. Había rivalidades y los cristianos decían cosas como: "Yo pertenezco a Pablo" o "Yo pertenezco a Cefas". Pero Pablo sabiamente pregunta: "¿Está dividido Cristo? ¿Pablo fue crucificado por ti? ¿O fuisteis bautizados en el nombre de Pablo? Claramente no. Solo hay una fuente de Verdad: Jesucristo, y Pablo nunca dudó en rechazar el crédito por sí mismo y, en cambio, glorificar al Señor en su palabra y obra. Este es el modelo establecido para nosotros: negarnos a ponernos a nosotros mismos a Dios hecho a nuestra propia imagen por encima y en contra del Dios Triuno que nos creó. Cristo vino a unirnos consigo mismo y entre nosotros, en reconciliación con el Padre. Sus palabras son ahora nuestras palabras: Arrepentíos y creed en el Evangelio. Ore por la gracia de unirnos como el cuerpo de Cristo para que podamos ser sus manos y sus pies en el mundo y llevar a cabo la obra que él comenzó.

### A EVANGELIZAR

ORACIÓN, INVITACIÓN, TESTIMONIO, ACOMPAÑAMIENTO

En Jesucristo el reino de Dios entra en la historia humana, cumpliendo la promesa de salvación de Dios para su pueblo. Cristo inauguró el reino en la tierra, y como miembros de su Iglesia somos responsables de seguir construyéndolo, aquí y ahora. Así como Cristo llamó a sus primeros discípulos y los hizo "pescadores de hombres", así nos llama a nosotros, para que podamos salir "proclamando el evangelio del reino, y curando toda enfermedad y dolencia en el pueblo".

Lleva ante el Señor a todos los que todavía necesitan oír su voz y arrepentirse y creer. Ore por aquellos que son perseguidos por su creencia en Jesucristo.

## COMO CONECTARNOS CON DIOS POR MEDIO DE LA ORACIÓN (1<sup>ra</sup> Parte)

Jeremías 29:12-14

Y me llamarás, e irás; y me orarás, y yo te oiré.  
Me buscaréis y me hallaréis: porque me buscaréis de todo vuestro corazón.

### Introducción

Como hijos de Dios hemos recibido muchos dones, uno de ellos es la mente que usamos para pensar. A través de nuestro razonamiento y luego de nuestra fe aceptamos que hay un Dios que escucha no solo nuestras palabras sino también nuestros pensamientos. Cuando oramos venimos en súplica ante Dios o cualquier ser espiritual superior como Nuestra Señora, los santos o los ángeles. Presentamos nuestras súplicas con humildad y esperamos ser contestadas.
